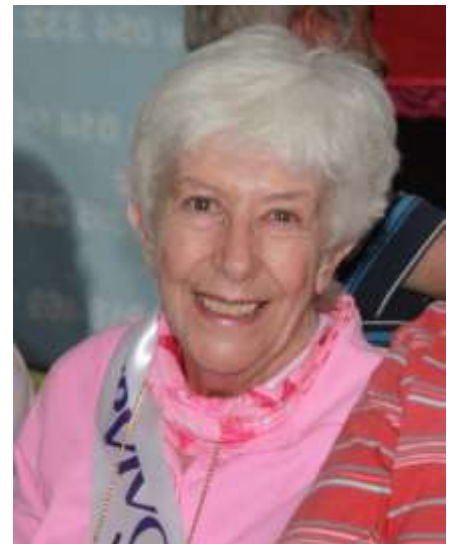


Ardath Datnow
